ATTENTION! It is the installer's responsibility to ensure all fasteners (including pre-assembled) are tightened before operation of the motorcycle. Kuryakyn will not warranty components lost due to improper installation. Periodic maintenance may be required.

TOOLS SUGGESTED

Set of hex wrenches, soapy water and a clean rag

PROCEDURE

STEP 1 Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface; turn off the ignition and allow the engine to cool.

STEP 2 Clean the brake lever with soapy water and a clean rag; allow the area to dry completely. See [PIC.1A](#).

STEP 3 Wipe the brake lever with the included alcohol wipe; allow the area to dry completely.

STEP 4 Rub the adhesive backing on the inside of the brake lever cover to activate the adhesive.

STEP 5 Remove the adhesive backing and position the cover on the brake lever. See [PIC.1B](#).

STEP 6 Press into place for at least 60 seconds for the best adhesion.

STEP 7 Remove the two screws on the topside of the pedal cover. See [PIC.1C](#).

STEP 8 Position the two cover halves around the stock brake pedal and secure them with the screws removed in STEP 7.
