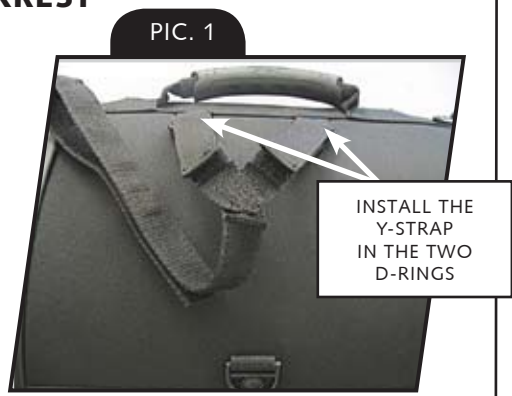
PROCEDURE FOR MOUNTING/SECURING TO BACKREST

STEP 1 Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition.

STEP 2 To install the tour bag on a backrest, install the Y-strap as shown in PIC. 1.

STEP 3 Place the Y-strap over the backrest and insert it through the lower D-ring, securing the hook and loop (PIC. 2).

STEP 4 Use the 8" straps and secure the bag around the arms of the backrest using the lower D-rings as shown in [PIC. 3](#).

STEP 5 If the backrest has a luggage rack, you also may use the additional straps on the front of the bag under the flap for additional security.

PROCEDURE FOR MOUNTING/SECURING TO TOUR-PAK LUGGAGE RACK OR SOLO LUGGAGE RACK

STEP 1 Place the bag on the rack and secure the bag to the rack using the straps that are under the flap on the front of the bag as shown in [PIC. 4](#).

STEP 2 Use the two 8" straps to secure the back of the bag to the rack as shown in [PIC. 5](#).
