PROCEDURE

STEP 1 Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition.

NOTE: It may be helpful to have assistance for the installation of this product.

STEP 2 Remove the saddlebags and set them on a soft clean blanket on a stable surface.

STEP 3 Remove the mat from the bottom of the Tour-Pak and disconnect any wiring/antennas from the Tour-Pak.

**STEP 4** Remove the two bolts, nuts and washers securing the left side of the Tour-Pak as shown in PIC. 1 and loosen the bolts on the right side, do not remove them.

**STEP 5** Carefully lift the left side of the Tour-Pak up and remove the spacers from under the bar.

**STEP 6** Lift up on the left side of the Tour-Pak and slide the left bracket (Refer to PIC. 2 to determine the left and right brackets) under the bar as shown in PIC. 3.

**STEP 7** Line up the holes in the Tour-Pak with the holes in the bracket and the holes in the bar. Re-install the hardware that was removed in STEP 4. Do not tighten the hardware at this point.

**STEP 8** Repeat STEP 4 through STEP 7 for the right side.

**STEP 9** Tighten the hardware securing the Tour-Pak.

**STEP 10** Replace the mat in the Tour-Pak and reconnect any wiring/antennas that were removed.

**STEP 11** Secure the armrest assemblies to the mounting brackets with the included 5/16-18 x 1" SHCS screws as shown in PIC. 4.

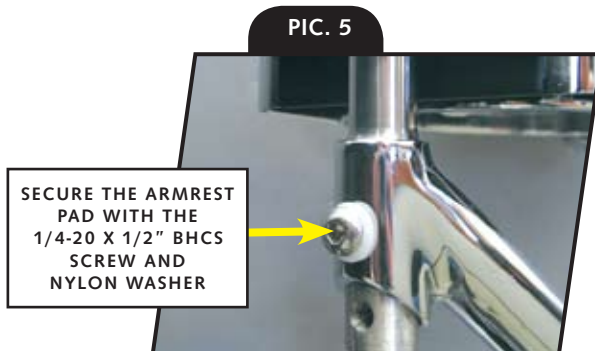
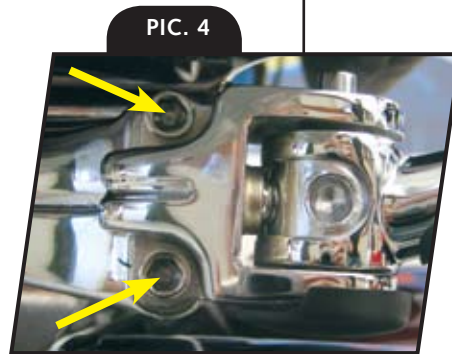
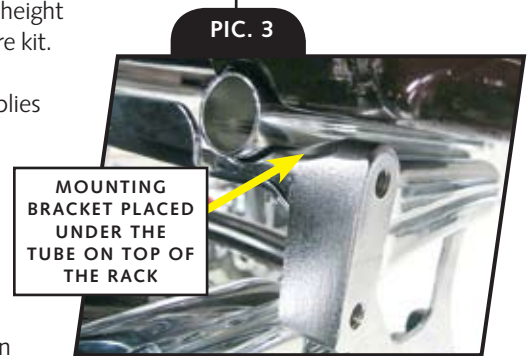
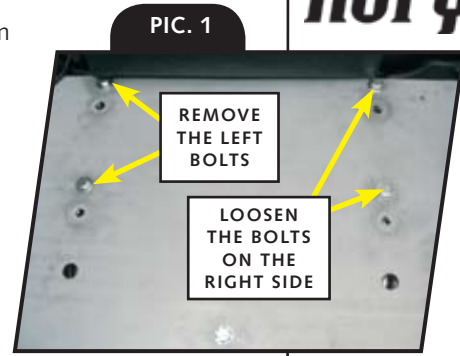
**STEP 12** Install the right armrest pad (the pad that has the drink holder) to the armrest assembly; determine the mounting height and secure with a 1/4-20 x 1/2" BHCS screw and a 1/4" nylon washer from the hardware kit. (PIC. 5)

**STEP 13** Install the left armrest pad to the armrest assembly; determine the mounting height and secure with a 1/4-20 x 1/2" BHCS screw and a 1/4" nylon washer from the hardware kit.

**STEP 14** Reinstall the saddlebags and check for clearance between the armrest assemblies and the saddlebags.

**CAUTION!** Do not use the armrest as an aid for boarding or dismounting the motorcycle. Damage to the armrest or motorcycle resulting from misuse is not covered by warranty.

**ATTENTION!** It is the installer's responsibility to ensure that all of the fasteners (including pre-assembled) are tightened before operation of the motorcycle. Kuryakyn will not warranty components lost due to improper installation. Periodic maintenance may be required.
